# **Ethnic Conflict Research Project: Unit 3**

This project will require you to research a significant ethnic conflict that has occurred in world history. Your ethnic conflict will be assigned to you. Your job is to compile your findings into a visually appealing research project that will be presented on poster or exhibit board.

### Questions that you must address:

- What lies at the heart of the conflict? (Why are they fighting?)
- What form does the fighting take? (War, genocide, terrorism, political unrest, etc.)
- What is the spatial extent of this conflict? (Does it occur in only one country, neighboring areas, or all over the globe?)
- How long has there been tension?
- How has the population been affected?
- What was the solution to this conflict? (If ongoing, what could the solution be?)

### **Exhibit Details**

- Must be compiled onto a poster board or trifold exhibit board
- Must include a minimum of five visuals, one of which MUST be a map
- Information on the exhibit may be printed or handwritten, but it MUST be legible
- You will be graded on:
  - Information (is it accurate? Did you use reliable sources?)
  - Creativity (Is it colorful? Do you have the minimum number of visuals? Are they relevant?)
  - Presentation of material (Is the information presented clearly? Are there details, examples, etc.? Does it look like it was thrown together last minute?)
- A list of sources is required.
